Primary School

Key Stage 1 Draw a picture that can be called “The Music Festival”, or just “Music”. It can be a memory of the festival or from your imagination. 2. Write about experience of music lessons during lockdown. (Did you have online lessons – what was that like?)
3. Draw a cartoon called ‘The Music Festival’. Should be at least 4 frames and must make us laugh!

There will be certificates for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each category and a small prize for each of the winners.
